

# The Arts in Medicine Collective Presents:

## “Healthcare Heroes in Action” Art Challenge

### Rules & Guidelines:

#### Eligibility:

The Arts in Medicine Collective's "Healthcare Heroes in Action" Art Challenge is open to all persons **aged 5-22 years old**.

Only one entry can be submitted per person to each art challenge.

An entry consists of a completed **entry form, artwork, and a short statement** (100-200 words) describing the participant's inspiration and the healthcare hero depicted.

Entries must abide by all guidelines stated here and on our website ([artsinmed.org](https://artsinmed.org)) and be submitted **by May 8, 2025, at 11:59 pm EST**.

#### Artwork Specifications:

- **Artwork should align with the theme: “Healthcare Heroes in Action”**
- **Artwork must be the contestant’s original creation** – while participants are free to use photos, videos, or artwork as inspiration, any submission that is an exact replica of another person’s work or AI generated will be disqualified.
- **Submissions also cannot depict any copyrighted materials or infringe on another's intellectual property.**
- Any visual art that can be captured as a still digital image, including paintings, sculptures, mixed media, drawings, collages, and digital mediums, can be submitted. There are no required size specifications for the work.
- Artwork must be free of any signatures or initials.

#### Entry Form Specifications:

- The entry form must be signed by both the artist and a supervising adult.
- Participants taking a photo of their work to upload should keep the following in mind:
  - Use a high resolution camera (it can be a phone camera). Photos should be between 3 and 10 MB in size.
  - Take the photo under indirect light to minimize glare.
  - Take the photo as straight on as possible to prevent any distortion.
  - Check to make sure your image is not blurry.
